Does your sister play volleyball by any chance?




zijn = his

haar = her


My aunt met her husband on holiday. Her cat often stays over at our house.



onzijdig zijn/haar = its

(deze kennen we niet in het NL)

onze = our

- een manier om een relatie aan te geven tussen persoon/dier/instantie en een zelfstandig naamwoord.
- Achter een bezittelijk voornaamwoord staat dus een zelfstandig naamwoord.

I love **my mother**.

This is **his girlfriend** Donna.

Our school is closed at the moment.

Our dog has its own house to sleep in.

They told me about their trip to London.

Persoonlijk voornaamwoord = onderwerp van de zin

I – you – he/she/it – we – you – they

- I love my bike.

Bezittelijk voornaamwoord staat altijd voor een zelfstandig naamwoord

my - your - his/her/its - our - you - their

- My bike is awesome!
