Wanneer je een zin maakt, zul je iets moeten doen met een werkwoord. Je kan tenslotte niet het hele werkwoord gebruiken bij elk onderwerp.

Bijvoorbeeld: spelen

- ✓ Wij spelen volleybal.
- X Hij **spelen** volleybal.
- Ik spelen volleybal.



Je zult het werkwoord moeten Vervoegen...

Ik **speel** volleybal en hij **speelt** golf. Gisteren hebben we nog Mario Kart **gespeeld**. In het Engels is dat natuurlijk niet anders.

I **play** volleyball and he **plays** golf. Just yesterday we have **played** Mario Kart.

Nog drie voorbeelden:

I **stayed** home last night.

He laughed really hard in class this morning.

They have travelled without their parents twice before.

I **stayed** home last night.

He **laughed** really hard in class this morning.

They have **travelled** without their parents twice before.

Wat valt op in bovenstaande zinnen?

Het Engels kent voor de verleden tijd of voltooid tegenwoordige tijd maar 1 vorm: Werkwoord+ed.

Er zijn echter 2 uitzonderingen.

Uitzondering 1
Het werkwoord to be (=zijn).

I was late at school this morning. You were a friend of Robin in Kindergarten, weren't you? He was at the disco last nigh. We were celebrating her birthday when her ex visited.

vervoegingen to be

I was you were he was she was it was

we were they were you were

De onregelmatige werkwoorden

Uitzondering 2

Onregelmatige werkwoorden

He brought (bring) me a gift and told (tell) me he was sorry.

I swam (swim) for half and hour and ate (eat) a sandwich at the beach. We have known (know) and them for over thirty years.

Deze werkwoorden kennen (bijna) geen regelmaat. In het modern Engels zijn er ongeveer 400. Voor school hoef je ze vast niet allemaal te kennen.

Onregelmatige werkwoorden

TIP: Je leert ze het beste in een vast ritme. Door ze samen te leren; het hele werkwoord (1e ritje), de verleden tijd (2e rijtje), de voltooide vorm (3e rijtje) en de vertaling (4e rijtje). Leer elk rijtje als een rijmpje, een korte rap.

to be	was/were	been	zijn/worden
to catch	caught	caught	vangen
to dream	dreamed	dreamt	dromen
to hit	hit	hit	slaan/raken
to swim	swam	swum	zwemmen

Onregelmatige werkwoorden

TIP 2: Sommige irregular verbs (onregelmatige werkwoorden) lijken op elkaar, die kun je bij elkaar zetten. Soms veranderen ze helemaal niet (oa. hit, cut, cost, let). Soms is het tweede en derde rijtje hetzelfde (oa. bleed, feel, get, have, pay). Soms eindigen ze in de voltooide vorm op –en (oa. break, choose, forbid, speak). Soms is het gewoon drie keer anders...

to hit - hit - hit / to cut - cut - cut / to cost - cost - cost / to let - let - let to bleed - bled - bled / to feel - felt - felt / to get - got - got / to have - had - had to break - broke - broken / to choose - chose - chosen / to speak - spoke - spoken to do - did - done / swim - swam - swum / to ring - rang - rung

Voor de voltooide tijd in het Engels gebruik je

have/has + voltooid deelwoord

Bij **regelmatige werkwoorden** is het voltooid deelwoord hetzelfde als de verleden tijd:

Past Simple: I worked at that shop yesterday.

Present Perfect: I have worked at that shop for three years.

Bij **onregelmatige werkwoorden** kan het hetzelfde zijn, maar is het vaak weer anders.

Past Simple: He saw that movie last weekend.

Present Perfect: He has seen that movie three times since it came out.
