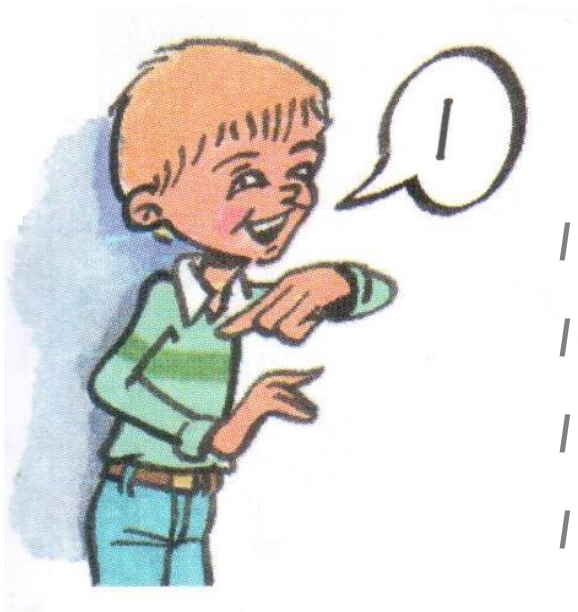

I am William.

I like my school, but hate to do my homework.



jij = you

You are my best friend.

You also play tennis.

You are wearing a red t-shirt.



hij = he

He is my grandfather.

He has grey hair.

He helps me with my homework.

zij = she

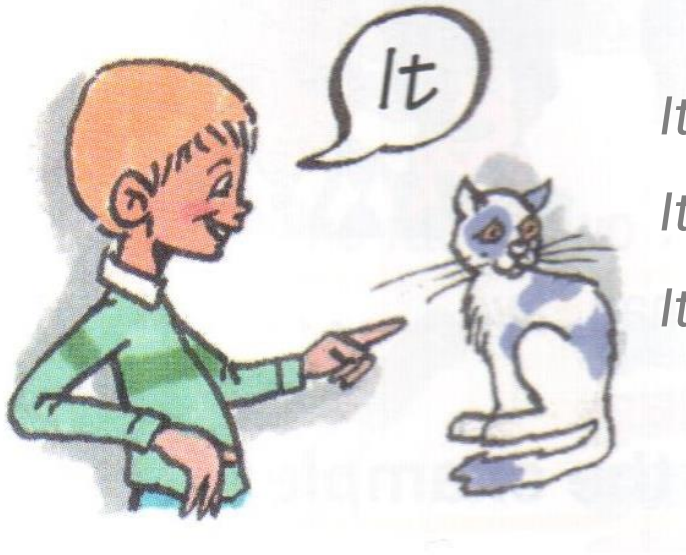


She is my mother.

She is married to my father.

She always asks me if I have homework.

het = it



It is a cat.

It has purple spots in its fur.

It's never outside.

wij = we



We are the Tanner's.

We live in a small village.

We have one cat and two goldfish.

zij = they

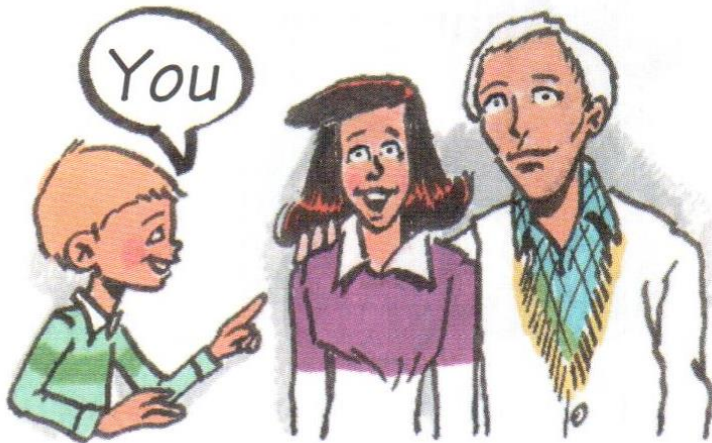


They are my parents.

They love me.

They have known each other for 22 years.

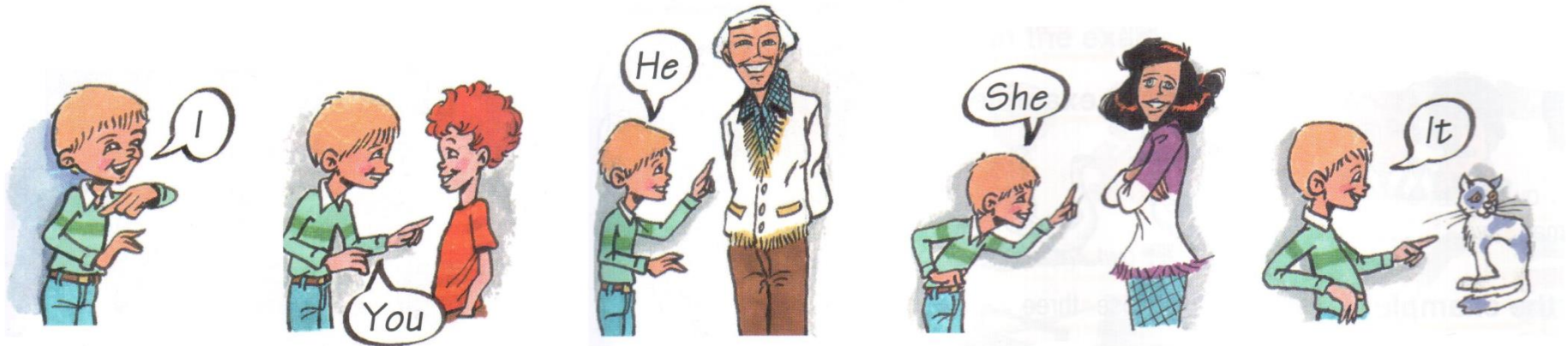
jullie = you

steeds 1 persoon: enkelvoud (ev)



Wat is het verschil tussen de bovenste en de onderste rij?



steeds meer dan 1 persoon: meervoud (mv)

Een persoonlijk voornaamwoord is..

- vaak het onderwerp van de zin. (subject pronouns)
- Kan ook een lijdend of meewerkend voorwerp zijn. (object pronoun)

Een persoonlijk voornaamwoord kan...

- een naam/namen vervangen.

Kevin was playing tennis with Audrey.

In deze zin is **Kevin** het onderwerp van de zin.

He gave a hug and left after the match.

In deze zin is **He** een persoonlijk voornaamwoord dat gebruikt wordt als onderwerp van de zin.

Een persoonlijk voornaamwoord dat als onderwerp in de zin staat noemen we de onderwerpsvorm van het persoonlijk voornaamwoord.
In het Engels: een **subject pronoun**.

De subject pronouns zijn

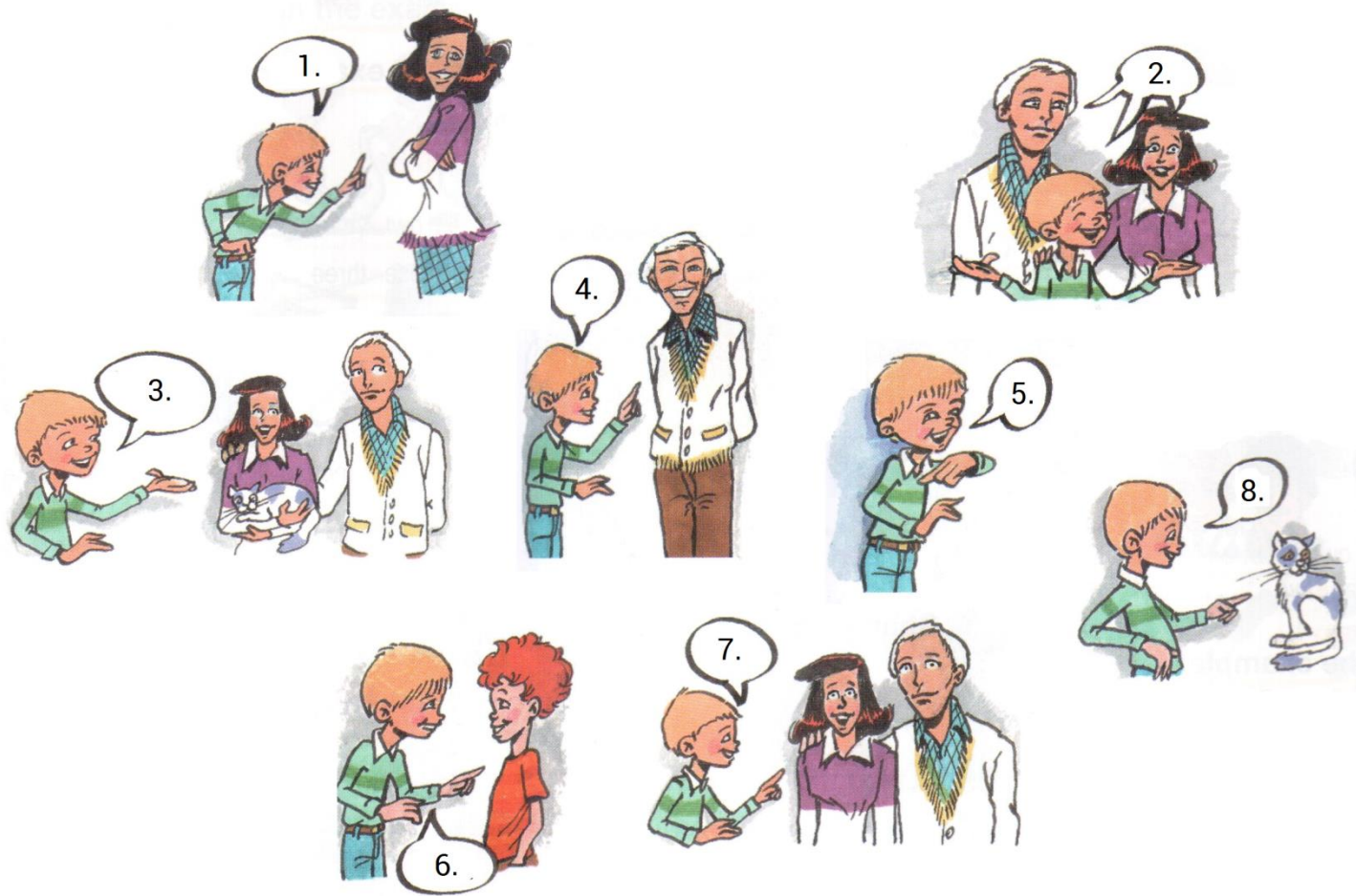

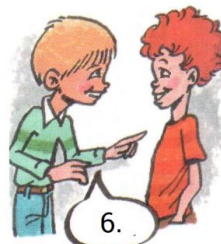
